Alachua	BoCC adopted zoning ordinance where MMD are permitted where pharmacies are located, required to be 500 ft from public and private schools	No plans
Bay	Made no changes to existing ordinance	No plans
Brevard	BoCC decided to allow MMTC's in all zoning districts where pharmacies are permitted	
Broward	Enacted Ordinance 2018-06; treating dispensing facilities like pharmacies	
Charlotte	BoCC voted on 10/24/17 to take no action and treating MMD the same as pharmacies	
Clay	Regulating MMD same as pharmacies	
Citrus	Implemented 180 day moratorium	Intends to draft changes to LDC to allow dispensaries anywhere the county allows pharmacies

Lake	BoCC banned MMD in unincorporated areas of County effective 11/17	
Leon		Have scheduled two public hearings for September to amend regulatory ordinance to conform to new statute
Levy		BoCC scheduled March public hearings for proposed ordinance banning MMD
Manatee	Planning Commission held public hearing on proposed amendment to Land Development Code	BOCC public hearings are planned for August 22, 2017 and September 7, 2017
Nassau		Draft ordinance will be considered by BOCC on September 25th which would allow facilities in the same zoning categories as pharmacies

Osceola	BoCC voted to ban MMD and exempted ones who already had permit	
Okaloosa	Adopted ordinance regulating medical marijuana dispensaries as pharmacies	
Okeechobee	BoCC adopted ordinance regulating MMD as pharmacies	
Palm Beach	BoCC repealed moratorium and treats MMD like pharmacies	
Pinellas	No action, thereby treating medical marijuana dispensaries in the same manner as pharmacies	
Polk	Updated Land Development Code to treat MMTC's the same as pharmacies	
Seminole	<u>BoCC adopted moratorium ordinance for 210 days expiring on 5/1/18</u>	Unknown on future regulation
St. Johns	STC currently under moratorium ordinance that runs to 3/31/18	BoCC has given direction to implement ban on MMD; proposed ordinance will be heard in March
St. Lucie	<u>BoCC adopted ordinance allowing MMD in same zoning districts as pharmacies</u>
